LUXEON V LEDs are tested and binned with a DC drive current of 1400mA at a junction temperature, T., of 85°C.

B B - designates CRI (70=70CRI minimum, 7T=70CRI typical)

c – designates SDCM (3=3-step MacAdam ellipse, 5=5-step MacAdam ellipse)

D D D D D - any alphanumeric character that designates performance options (For example, 0 = standard)




Figure 1. Maximum permissible operating conditions for LUXEON V




Figure 2. Typical normalized power vs. wavelength for LUXEON V at 1400mA, T_i=85°C




Figure 3. Typical normalized light output vs. junction temperature for LUXEON V at 1400mA, T_i=85°C




Figure 4. Typical normalized light output vs. forward current for LUXEON V at 1400mA, T_i=85°C




Figure 5. Typical forward current vs. forward voltage for LUXEON V at T_i =85°C




Figure 6. Typical radiation pattern for LUXEON V at 1400mA, T_i=85°C




Figure 7. Typical polar radiation pattern for LUXEON V at 1400 mA, T_i = 85 °C

Product Bin and Labeling Definitions

Decoding Product Bin Labeling

In the manufacturing of semiconductor products, there are variations in performance around the average values given in the technical datasheet. For this reason, Lumileds bins LED components for luminous flux or radiometric power, color point, peak or dominant wavelength and forward voltage.

LUXEON V LEDs are labeled using a 4-digit alphanumeric CAT code following the format below:

ABCD

Where:

A - designates luminous flux bin (example: U=510 to 540 lm, X=600 to 630 lm)

B C – designates color bin (example: 13, 5A, 5B, 5C, 5D)

D - designates forward voltage bin (example: G=2.85 to 3.00V, H=3.00 to 3.20V)

Therefore, a LUXEON V with a lumen range of 510 to 540 lm, color bin of 5A and a forward voltage range of 2.85 to 3.00V has the following CAT code:

U 5 A G

Luminous Flux Bins

Table 5 lists the standard luminous flux bins for LUXEON V emitters. Although several bins are outlined, product availability in a particular bin varies by production run and by product performance. Not all bins are available in all CCTs.






Figure 8. Color space definition for LUXEON V




Figure 10. Mechanical dimensions for LUXEON V




Figure 11. Visualization of the acceptable reflow temperature profile as specified in Table 8




Figure 12. Recommended PCB solder pad layout for LUXEON \




Figure 13. Pocket tape dimensions for LUXEON V




Figure 14. Reel dimensions for LUXEON V
